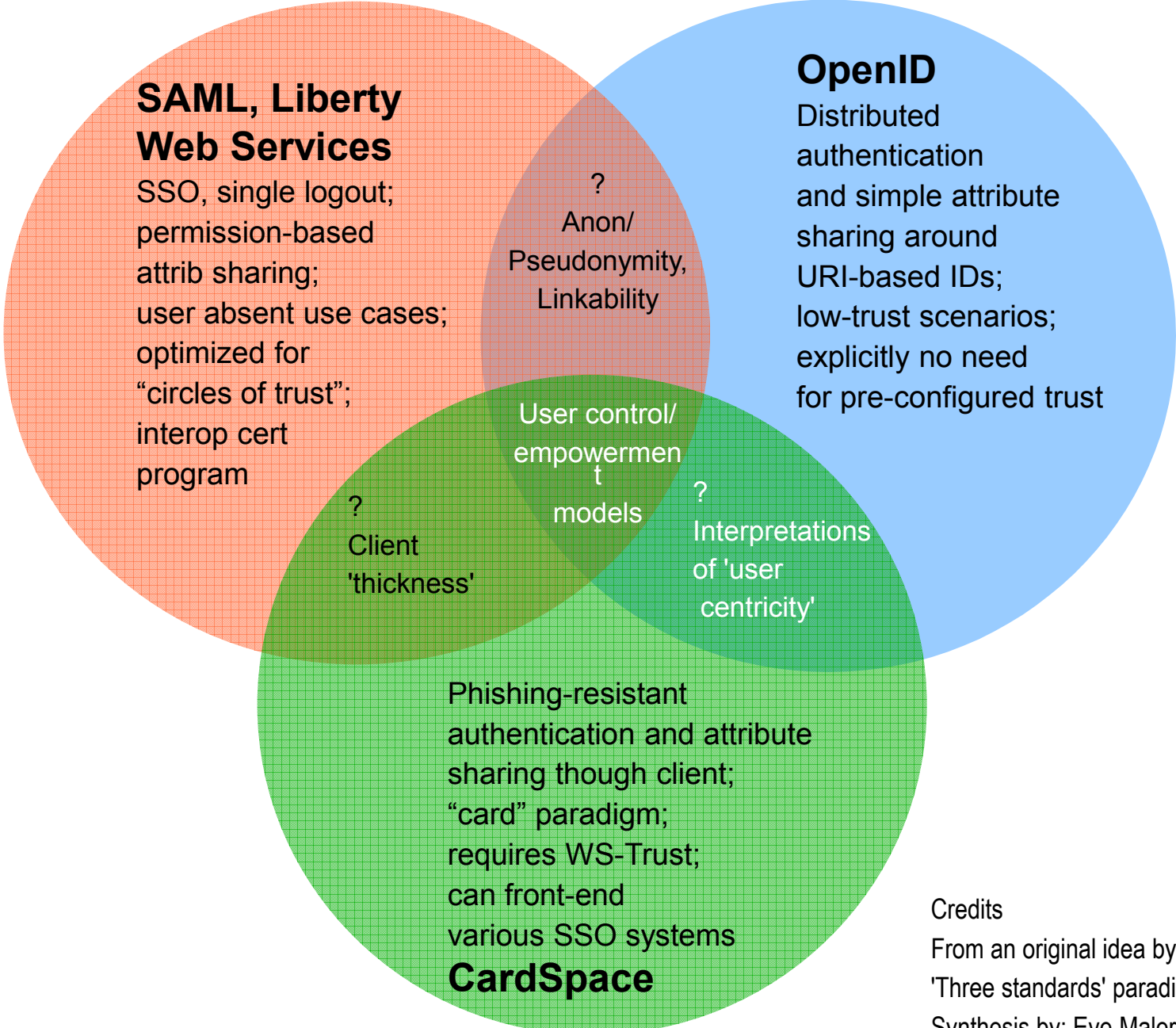

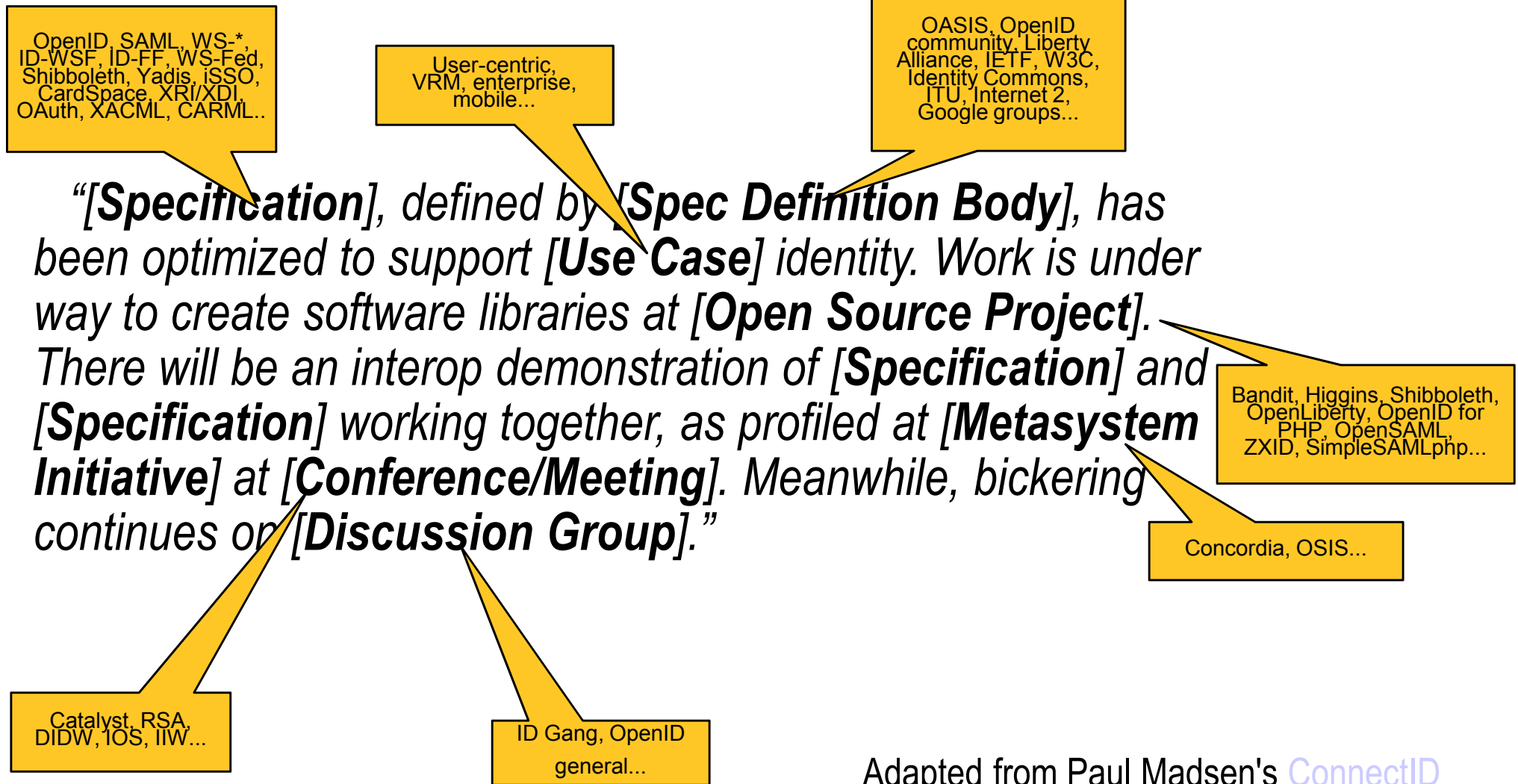

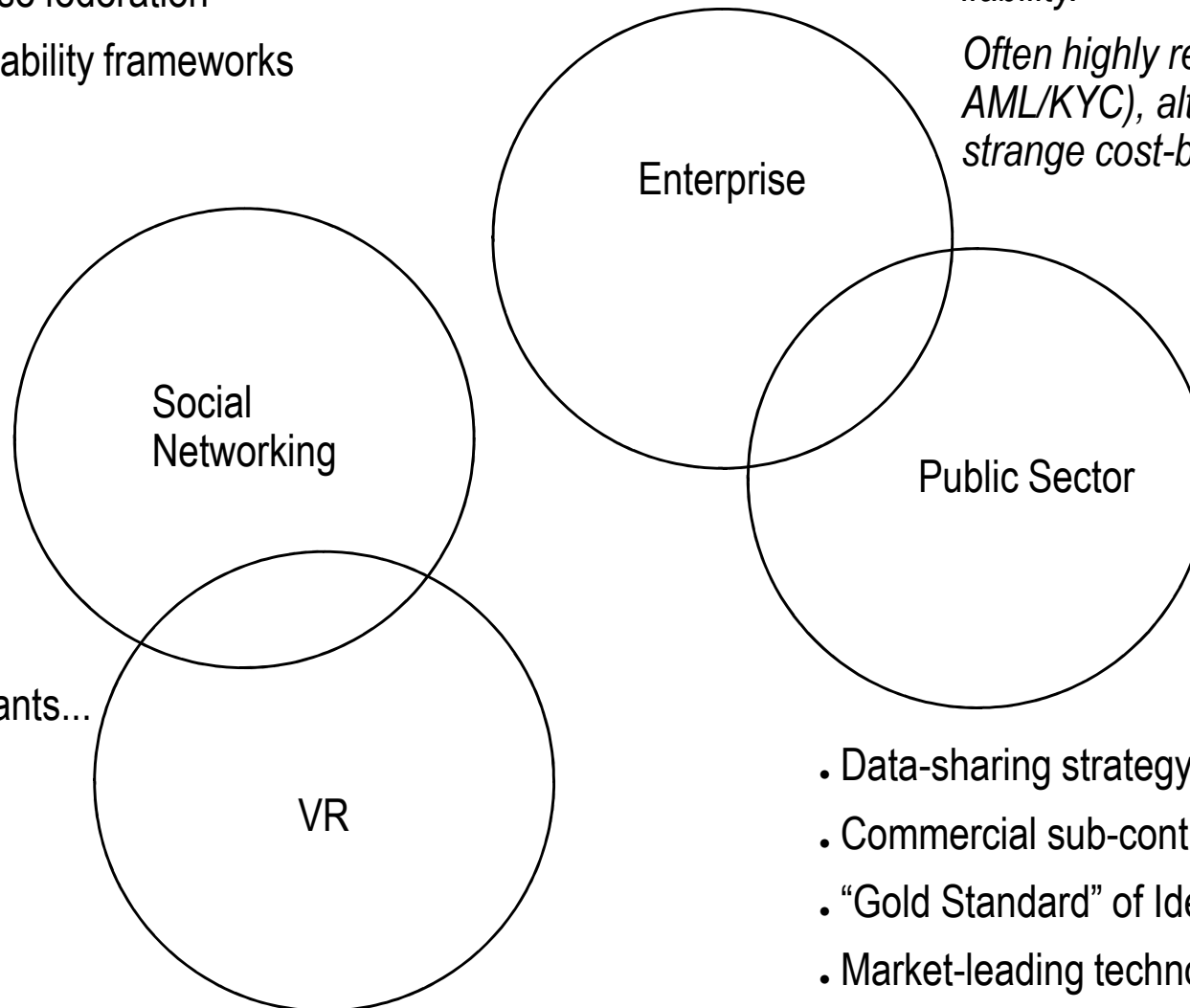

Robin's 'Venn of Identities'

- Intra-enterprise IDM
- Inter-enterprise federation
- Contractual liability frameworks

Characterised by relatively mature notions of registration/verification and liability.

Often highly regulated (Basel II, S-Ox, AML/KYC), although sometimes with strange cost-benefit equations.



- The mystery entrants...

- Data-sharing strategy
- Commercial sub-contractors
- “Gold Standard” of Identity?
- Market-leading technology and governance?

PPEG's observations (1)

- What's the problem?
- We see:
 - > Implementers confused by complex technical landscape
 - > Technologists challenged by policy/compliance requirements (Data Protection, Privacy Law, Fair Use...)
 - > Policy-makers frustrated by technology (“Why can't privacy be baked in at the technology layer?”)
 - > Customer frustration (“Why does all this technology still not address the problem space?”)
